POLICY FOR USE OF TELEPHONES BY THE PUBLIC

Main Library

- A. The library does not provide telephones for public use. The only exceptions are the following:
 - 1. A child or teen may make one phone call to a parent or guardian during a visit to the library.
 - 2. An adult may make an emergency call for such situations as car trouble.
 - a. Staff member will dial the number.
 - 3. A call made to emergency 911 will be placed by a staff member.
- B. The only telephones available for use by the public at the Main Library are the telephone at the north end of the Adult Circulation desk and the telephone at the west end of the Children's Services desk.

Hope Branch Library

- A. The library does not provide telephones for public use. The only exceptions are the following:
 - 1. A child or teen may make one phone call to a parent or guardian during a visit to the library.
 - 3. An adult may make an emergency call for such situations as car trouble.
 - a. Staff member will dial the number.
 - 3. A call made to emergency 911 will be placed by a staff member.
- B. The only telephone available for use by the public at Hope Branch is the telephone at the Circulation desk.

Bookmobile

- A. The telephone on the Bookmobile is not for public use. The Bookmobile staff can make the following exceptions.
 - 1. An adult may make an emergency call for such situations as car trouble.
 - a. Staff member will dial the number.
 - 2. A call made to emergency 911 will be placed by a staff member.
